Get Connected:

- 2. Describe a time when you were not invited/welcomed. What three words best describe how you felt?
- 3. What would it look like for Pathway Church to be the most inviting/welcoming place in the DFW area?

In the Word:

Read Luke 14:1-6

- 1. In Jesus' time, Pharisees were rule followers who were careful about who was invited in and who was not. Which person did not "fit" in at the table?
- 2. What did Jesus do and why?

Read Luke 14:15-24

- 1. The banquet in this parable is the Kingdom of God. Who is invited?
- 2. Who turns down the invitation? Who accepts? Why?
- 3. How does this parable sound to the Pharisees sitting around the table deciding who is in and who is out?

Apply:

- 1. Would you describe your relationship with Jesus as more trying to fit in or as belonging?
- 2. On a scale of 1-5, 1 being indifferent, 5 being passionate, how determined are you to step into the "awkward" so everyone knows they are invited to be a part of God's family?
- 3. Identify someone you genuinely want to get to know better so you can help connect them to Jesus. What is your next step to develop that relationship?
- 4. Who are you inviting to the "party?" Why?
