with me in the pain, just as Jesus was on the cross."

a. Pray: "Yet this I call to mind, and t	:herefore I have hope: Because of t	he LORD's great love we are
not		
consumed, for his compassions r	never fail. They are new every morr	ning; great is your faithfulness. I
say to myself, "The LORD is my portion; therefore I will wait for him."		

Life Steps

It's Ok to Not be Ok: Faith, Doubt, & Disappointment | October 19 & 20, 2024

Monday Lamentations 3:18-20

Reflect: Real faith is having the courage to name your suffering and doubts before God and know God cares for you. For today, just name a moment or doubt you are carrying that you need to get real with God about. Refer back to this moment in the coming days through the daily Life Steps. **Prayer:** God, even in the valley of doubt and death, I trust you. Because of your great love, I am not consumed. This I call to mind, and therefore I have hope.

Tuesday Lamentations 1:15-16

Reflect: As you get real with God about your place of doubt or suffering, has it ever felt like God had left you alone in your suffering? It's ok to say to God that, even though you know he's with you, it still feels like you are alone. But remember, God suffers with you in these places.

Prayer: God, even in the valley of doubt and death, I trust you. Because of your great love, I am not consumed. This I call to mind, and therefore I have hope.

Wednesday Colossians 2:5-8

Reflect: Reflecting on your place of doubt or suffering, remember that Christ literally joins you in this place of suffering. Take this moment of doubt or suffering and place it next to the cross with Jesus. How might his suffering presence on the cross provide you with hope?

Prayer: God, even in the valley of doubt and death, I trust you. Because of your great love, I am not consumed. This I call to mind, and therefore I have hope.

Thursday Lamentations 2:15

Reflect: Have you ever been in a place where maybe you knew God was with you, but it seemed like the world was against you? Or maybe you've been in a situation where the world was humbling you in a painful way. It's ok to name this place of suffering to God. Take a moment to talk about this moment to God. Invite him into this place with you.

Prayer: God, even in the valley of doubt and death, I trust you. Because of your great love, I am not consumed. This I call to mind, and therefore I have hope.

Friday Matthew 27:38-40

Reflect: Just as we suffer through humbling experiences as the world watches, remember that the world watched Jesus in his suffering as well. Faith is forged in these moments, if you are willing. The question is, are you willing?

Prayer: God, even in the valley of doubt and death, I trust you. Because of your great love, I am not consumed. This I call to mind, and therefore I have hope.

Saturday Lamentations 3:18-24

Reflect: Ultimately, faith is a choice. We name our doubts, our disappointments, our sufferings. But as we do this, we have the opportunity to say, "yet, God, I trust in you. Even in this moment, I know I have hope in you." As you continue to reflect on these trying experiences, look for the places where you can choose faith.

Prayer: God, even in the valley of doubt and death, I trust you. Because of your great love, I am not consumed. This I call to mind, and therefore I have hope.

Sunday Psalm 13

Reflect: This psalm reminds us of the pain that accompanies life. But it also reminds us that we can choose to trust in God. As you prepare for worship, choose faith today. Then, celebrate this faith with someone else.

Prayer: God, even in the valley of doubt and death, I trust you. Because of your great love, I am not consumed. This I call to mind, and therefore I have hope.
